


# Changing Properties


Use Edit | Properties to change the properties of objects.


Select an object...

and choose Edit | Properties.




A dialog box shows up.

The Object panel describes the object.




To see the Values panel, click this tab.

change the precision.


Don't click OK yet.



Go to the Label panel...


Type a new label...

and now click OK.




The label and the precision change.


A SHORTCUT: Right-click (Windows) or Ctrl-click (Mac) an object...

What are Parents and Children?

It's handy to know how objects in a sketch are related. We used points A and B to make segment AB, so points A and B are the parents of the segment. Similarly, segment AB is the child of points A and B.
