Make Objects and Text Easier to See

Select a point and choose **Display | Point Style | Large**.

Points will now be easier to see and select.

You can also make segments, lines, and rays thick.

Use the Text Palette to make labels and captions bigger...

and bold.

Make Objects Easier to Select

Choose **Edit | Preferences** and go to the Tools panel.

Check this box to make it less likely you'll accidentally deselect objects.

Set magnetism to High to make it easier to select the objects you want.

Use the Marker Tool

Using the **Marker** tool...

to draw and write on a sketch...

and call attention to relationships.
