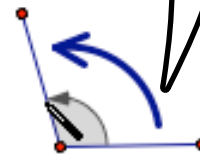
Make Angle Markers

tool and...



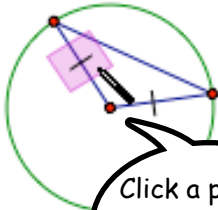
press and drag

angle to the other...

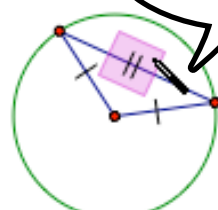


to create an
angle marker.

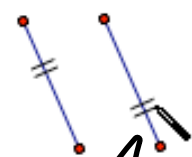
Make Tick Marks



Click a path to
create a tick
mark.

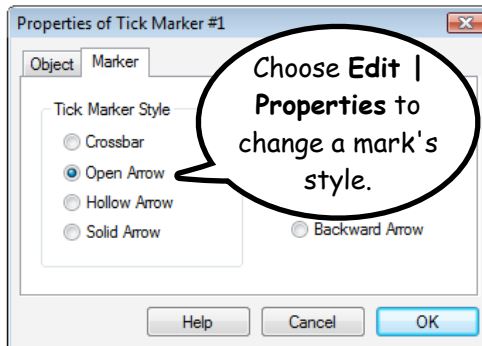
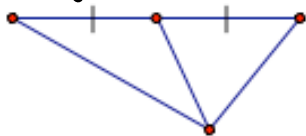


Click again to

number of ticks.



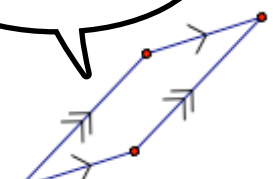
You can drag a

style.

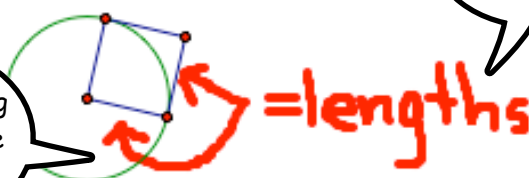
You can use open
arrows to represent
parallel lines.



Make Freehand Drawings



Press and drag
in white space
to draw...



or add
handwritten
text.

You can select, move, resize,
and transform a drawing.

Use **Display | Color** to set the
ink color.
